Teenagers Leave Town Behind for Night of Mayhem, Love and High-Speed Thrills

A wave of trouble swept through the city late last night as a teenage boy and girl—believed to be high school sweethearts—left a trail of destruction in their wake.

Police say the pair stole a '57 Chevrolet and led officers on a dangerous high-speed chase before crashing through the front window of the Starlite Diner.

They were last seen heading west on Highway 99.
